Feedback given by Norma re a field visit FAB members and friends met with Johanna Willi, Biodiversity Co-Ordinator, Fife Council, on 17 July to discuss the management of the pond and meadow. The following action points emerged:-	
 meadow – in autumn, cut grass (rough), remove hay, and seed. In winter sow yellow rattle (frost germinates). The following spring, the grass given a high cut (minimises damage to wildflowers). A tidy up day has been agreed. 	Action Day 26 th August 11.00- 13.00 meet at
pond – autumn/winter dredge a section of the pond, set aside detritus for a few days enabling insects etc to return to pond, then remove.	10.00 to collect


Wassailing January 2019 -date to be set /19th or 201th. Approach Jill to organise?
